Everyone engaging with our programmes or events is encouraged to read and follow this Code of Conduct which aligns with A New Direction's values.

Equity	Be respectful of differences and remember that equity means giving
	each person the support they need to succeed.
	 Don't talk over people, everyone has the right to speak, and all
	opinions are valid.
	 Leave any biases and/or assumptions outside and do not make
	assumptions about others or how they identify.
Connectivity	 Participate with generosity and a willingness to collaborate.
	• This is precious time to connect with others — engage and be present.
	 Build connections - ask questions and offer help, make suggestions, or
	follow up a conversation after the activity you're taking part in.
Trust and Respect	 Notifications off or on silent – please try to reduce distractions for yourself and others.
	• All sessions/events will start assuming everyone has engaged with any
	reading material sent in advance.
Creative Culture	 Be open to meeting new people who are different to you.
	 Be open to trying new ways of doing things, but please always share
	your boundaries and let someone know if you are uncomfortable.
Kindness	 Be patient and understanding when working together — don't assume
	you know what's going on in someone's day.
	 Calling out and calling in — everyone is encouraged to share if a
	dynamic or behaviour makes them uncomfortable.
